What?

Panopto is the lecture capture solution currently supported at WSU. In addition to lecture capture, Panopto is an easy-to-use personal presentation capturing software, allowing users to record, edit, and share their recordings. Panopto can capture your screen, audio, and video inputs from webcams and other devices to record live lectures, demonstrations, and other supplemental materials. Panopto is integrated with Blackboard so videos may be viewed only by users enrolled in a Blackboard course or made public for anyone to view.

When?

- Record a demonstration/tutorial so students can watch several times if necessary
- Walk students through directions of an assignment or project with a video
- Provide students with audio/video feedback about their assignments and papers (e.g. think aloud when reviewing assignment)
- Record a weekly 'key ideas' summary of the class and give an overview of future assignments
- Students can also use Panopto to create presentations for other students or only the instructor to view.
