### What?

A VoiceThread is a collaborative, multimedia slide show that holds images, documents, and videos and allows people to navigate slides and leave asynchronous comments in 5 ways - using voice, text, drawing, audio file, or video. A person can share a VoiceThread as a url with friends, students, and colleagues, or submit to an assignment drop box in Blackboard.
